Lyudmyla Zakopets (Ukraine)

Professsor of piano at the Lviv State Music Lyceum named after Solomiya Krushelnytska (Ukraine). Coordinator & Professor of International Piano Forum "Beshchady bez kordoniv" (Poland). She is also an organizer and director of the first international young pianist competition "Feurich-virtuos" in Lviv and "Bechstein". Over the years of teaching, the achievements are: 90 prizewinners of international and national competitions, 40 performances with symphonic and chamber orchestras in Ukraine, Germany, Poland and other countries.
